Devin Solovey our Golf Course Superintendent, kindly provided a "State of the Course". His update is as follows:

"We are one month closer to golf season. I walked the course after our first thaw and I am pleased to inform you that our golf course has come through the first stint of weather healthy. During the winter season, I like to see snow cover. The snow acts almost like a greenhouse protecting the turf from the harsh conditions of winter.

Our thaws also have worked out well. We are having enough time for snow melt to percolate through the soil profile. This process has prevented ice sheets from forming when the next cold spell hits. Ice sheets suffocate the turf and can cause problems in the spring. I haven't noticed any snow mold on our fine turf which is a great sign that we applied our fungicide treatment at the proper time.

I do hope for more snow as it will protect the turf from wind and freezing temperatures that cause winter desiccation. The grounds crew has been busy repairing equipment and the maintenance facility. We look forward to seeing everyone in the spring."
