I am pleased that spring is finally upon us! The grounds crew spent the extra shop time refurbishing ball washers, trash cans, benches, range equipment and bunker rakes. This gives the course a clean look going into the season. You may have noticed bunker rake stands as a new addition to our course. Please make sure that rakes get put back in the holder. We have been busy removing sick or dead trees and mulching flower beds. I will also be removing stumps. This is a loud process, to do it efficiently I will not be able to stop for play. I apologize in advance for the inconvenience. I would also like to apologize for the scattered debris and pine cones in the rough. We mulch these areas with the rough mower. Therefore with the rough slow to green up it is slowing the process. The last few weeks we have been working on a green surround project on one. The bunkers have been removed and replaced with mounds similar to 8 green. We will be sodding the area over the next couple weeks. Thanks for the update Devin!
