Unfortunately, we are about half way through the golf season. This season has been interesting. Our winter carried on into spring longer than expected. During spring we had record amounts of precipitation following a month of low humidity and high heat. It has been a stressful year on our playing surfaces. The cultural practice such as venting greens, spring and fall aeration and top-dressing has improved the condition of greens tremendously. During wet conditions these practices allow percolation of water through the soil profile. Fracturing the profile allows for gas exchange also allowing plant roots the ability to mine deeper. Deeper roots equal better drought tolerance. We have experienced minimal turf loss on playing surface. Most of which is poa annua. Although poa can be a superior putting surface in cool conditions, during hot dry spells it checks out due to shallow root structures. Over the last week we have seeded stressed areas on greens and approaches. I will be seeding drought stressed areas in fairways over the next month. I would like to thank all the members who attended the annual meeting this year. It is great to hear your thoughts and concerns. I would also encourage more members to attend these meetings allowing us to address your needs and serve you better.
