With that said we will be increasing our dues 2% in 2019 to allow MCC to staff in this tough labor market and carry out the business of Maplecrest Country Club. This increase adjusts the family golf membership \$55 for the year.

As you may remember last year we had a generous donation of \$20,000. which was matched by our membership for a combined \$41,000. Many members have also stepped up and are making a monthly commitment to this fund. (MCC THANKS YOU) The Capital Improvements Fund was established to keep the use of these funds separate from “operating expenses”. This fund was used to purchase a Fairway Aerator , (equipment MCC leased in the past), Outside Lights around our club. We have approximately \$5500. in this fund which is not enough to begin to fund aging equipment and facility. Looking ahead to 2019 we will be invoicing all members \$200 for the year (payable in one or monthly payments) to continue the replacement of much needed equipment. I do believe this fund is a necessity to provide a country club experience that is a source of pride for the members, and provides enjoyment and a desire to return for both members and their guests.
