The membership will also have access to the program (by request) and will be able to send out invitations to players, make pairings, and have results at events away from the club (trips). Thanks to Carl and Parker for spearheading this project.

There have been many changes over the years and the club is headed in the right direction. Thank you to everyone who donates their time to make our little course an enjoyable place to be. Hard to believe the season is winding down. As many of you have probably observed we are in the “winterizing” phase of our operation. Greens aeration went very well, with us having the opportunity to do it in Mid-September things are recovering nicely and things should be back to normal before we get any really cold temps.

Soon we will be blowing out the irrigation system, winterizing the halfway house and the cart barn. This is an important time of year to “protect” the golf course, per our normal schedule we will be putting down our fall fertilizer application in the coming weeks.

When temperatures allow for course traffic we will start the tree removal process on the existing dead/problem trees throughout.
