Happy early Spring, MCC! As I look at the favorable forecast over the first week of March, the weather appears it is going to cooperate with our early opening of the course with our new carts this weekend. We've already had 100+ rounds logged in the month of February for walking only players, which is amazing. Thanks to Devin and his team for getting the course in a position to open so early.

As we get a chance to get out and play, just a friendly reminder to stay on the cart paths as much as possible and obey all "No Cart" signs as there are inevitably going to be soft areas that need to be avoided. While mother nature has cooperated enough to allow the course to open, we know the course conditions cannot yet be at the level we see in the middle of season. Let's just be thankful we can get out in the fresh air and enjoy this wonderful game a little early this year!

Looking back at the first two months of 2024, it is always slower at MCC during the winter months. That being said, I want to thank everyone who frequented the Club in January and February. We had some wonderful Elevated Dining opportunities, as well as a special Valentine's Dinner and a Wine Dinner. Kudos to the kitchen staff for preparing some delicious meals for those events. Those dinners, coupled with a few private events, have allowed the Club to generate more revenue YTD than we saw last year, which helps lessen the net hole that we annually begin each year.

Back to the golf course: As we start getting out and experiencing the grounds, we will notice a few changes as some trees were removed, but we were also able to plant some replacements with the mild February temps. An unexpected tree loss was the large Silver Maple on the left side of 18 Fairway that Carl already informed the Club about last month in his daily postings. This tree was not designated for removal; however, it split during a storm and when assessed it was determined it would not survive. I understand this tree held a lot of sentimental value to many members. We have planted a London Plane Tree to replace it, as it will mimic a Sycamore and is a faster growing option.

Other tree removals/replacements included:

Removal of a Black Locust behind 16 Green as it was nearing end of life. It was replaced with two Red Maples (one of which is a memorial tree for Jere Eaton) to better frame the green.

Please do your best to email Kristin at bar@maplecrestcountryclu b.org and let us know your coming. Not only does it help to better serve you but it also helps to manage labor in the slow season. Removal of two Silver Maples, one Red Oak and one Black Locust near 5 Green / 6 Tee. The Silver Maples are now considered an invasive species that are no longer to be planted in Indiana. These trees being removed will allow more morning sunlight onto 5 Fairway to help dry it out, similar to what we did for 15 Fairway a couple years ago. We have replaced with two Sugar Maples and another London Plane. Removal of three more Silver Maples on 8, including the large one to the left of 8 green. It is now best practice not to plant a tree within 30

feet of a green. We have replaced with two Cherry trees to better frame the hole.

I want to thank Carl, Devin and the Golf/Greens Committee for their work on these tree projects. A lot of thought and planning has gone into these

A lot of thought and planning has gone into these decisions, so the trees are placed in a position that not only works today but hopefully for generations to come. Additional tree replacements are planned for the interior of the course but must wait until we have completed the oncourse drainage project in the coming years. We continue to work on getting the off-site drainage project completed hopefully later this year.
