Happy New Year all! While it is maybe a little late for that since it is mid-January already it just means we are that much closer to golf season. Carl and Sophie have posted the 2026 golf schedule. Please make sure you check it out and start marking dates on your calendar.

As we prepare for this year's season our 2nd phase of golf course drainage project is underway. Devin and his crew have removed all the sod in necessary areas to begin replacing our main drainage tile on the golf course. This tile begins on hole 14, runs across 4, 3, 2, over to hole 6 making a slight turn toward hole 5 and connects to our offsite tile in front of hole 12. Personally, I am very excited to see what the on-course drainage does for the playability of the golf course. With the improvement of the drainage from the off-course drainage project I think all members will be pleasantly surprised. Now does this mean we will be able to play an hour after a heavy downpour....no, but it should limit us from having the multiple day closures from heavy rains.

Now that the parking lot project is complete, we have completed the other upgrades that went with the parking lot project. The retaining walls by the cart barn, far east by the tennis courts, and in front of the clubhouse are all now complete. Big thank you to Gary Zimmerman and Masterscapes for their work on the retaining walls. Trees and bushes are being planted this week and later this spring to put the finishing touches on the project.

Over the last 3 years we have upgraded our clubhouse area with a new steel roof, painted/stained the outside brick, added a new composite deck that doesn't need to be stained every year, and the parking lot project. The MCC board is discussing painting the cart barn to make our outside refresh complete. The roof on the cart barn needs a little attention and we believe painting the cart barn will finish the clubhouse area upgrading nicely. Quotes are being collected and the board will be reviewing those quotes in the next two months.

That is all I have for now. Do not forget about the 2026 Golf Cart Pass Giveaway. All you need to do is come to eat & drink at the club to earn entries. As always make sure you call with reservations when you can. It helps the staff be prepared for the best dining experience.

Hello Members! Hopefully all of you had a great holiday season. We are happy to report that when turf has been uncovered from snow it has been healthy and handled the early Winter well to this point. Right now we are knee deep in our biggest on course project to date with the new oncourse drainage tile.

See below for a few highlights.

-Spent the month of December pulling sod for the tile while also working to locate infrastructure.

-Over the next week we (plan) to haul in bedding stone and excavation equipment so that we are set.

-The plan (weather permitting...need frozen ground) is to begin installing the onsite drainage tile with hopes to have it in as soon as possible.

When not focusing on the new tile we continue to prep all equipment, sharpen reels, and get on course accessories back up to speed for another season.

A lot of good things going on that will provide an opportunity for even healthier turf in places that have proven to be difficult to maintain at a high level in the past.

We appreciate your support and will give an update over the coming weeks!
