A LETTER FROM KEVIN GRABER, CLUB PRESIDENT

Happy Spring everyone! As we start moving into the warmer weather I know everyone is itching to get on the golf course. As you have seen with the daily updates the finishing touches are being put on the 2nd phase of golf course drainage project. Devin and his crew have backfilled and leveled all the dirt after placing the new tile in the trench. This tile begins on hole 14, runs across 4, 3, 2, over to hole 6 making a slight turn toward hole 5 and connects to our offsite tile in front of hole 12. All the sod in the rough areas has been placed, and the crew is currently laying the fairway sod on each hole. Once sod is laid it will be roped off. We will have specific gravel crossing spots for carts for the time being. **AT NO POINT SHOULD YOU DRIVE A CART IN THE ROPED OFF AREAS.** For these areas to recover properly we need everyone to keep carts out of those areas. You can walk in to get a ball so you can take a proper drop as we don't want anyone playing out of these areas either. Anyone seen violating these areas will be suspended from the club for 30 days.

As you can see, I'm very passionate about this because our grounds crew, led by Devin Solovey have worked and continue to work extremely hard on these areas and getting them ready for summer. This was a very big project and Devin, and his team stepped up to the task. Working extra hours when weather permitted to keep this project moving forward. The excess rain this spring has made it tough but with some used equipment purchases and researched sod cutting/saving techniques Devin and this team were able to reuse sod we cut from our own fairways and stored safely over winter. If we had to purchase new sod for the fairways we would have spent between \$50-\$60 thousand dollars. We spent half of that on the purchase of used equipment, equipment that will be used going forward for course improvements, and as mentioned were able to reuse our own sod to make it all happen. The board of directors over the last 3-4 years have made some noticeable changes and improvements to the golf course and club house. We are doing our best to make sure Maplecrest's future is bright but making improvements in the most cost-effective ways. This project shows what we can do as a club as our membership continues to grow and we make improvements to MCC.

We are going to host our membership meeting at 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday May 20th. I hope to see a large turnout from the membership. Our board of directors will be in attendance and after a brief summary of Maplecrest's financial position and potential upcoming projects we will open the floor for questions from the membership.

If you didn't make it to the Masters Tournament draw on Friday April 3rd you missed out. Carl, Sophie, Spencer, Kristin, Kelsey, and Lexi hosted a great event in the bar with live music mixed in-between the Masters picks. The kitchen staff led by Mike and Melinda had a great fajita buffet. Those in attendance had a great time...including myself.

Golf season is getting started. Men's and Women's leagues will both start in less than a month. The 4 person/2 Best Ball tournament is on Saturday May 2nd. I've got my team ready, do you? Please help Carl and his team by making tee times on the app. Carl has posted about it everyday in March and April. Just as important of making a tee time is cancelling a tee time if you aren't going to use it. We don't want to penalize people for making tee times and not showing up but we will if we have too. We expect a busy course this spring and summer so please be very aware of the tee-time situation. The same goes for any tournament signups. If you sign up and find you can't play, please make sure to cancel your entry. Popular events like Friday night couples and the Big Hole scramble fill up fast. We have seen people sign up and then not show up for the event. When that happens more than likely we turn people away that wanted to play. Let's make sure everyone that wants to play gets a chance too!

That is all for now. I feel like I wrote a book that had a lot of "rules" for our membership, but I only say these things because I care. I care about Maplecrest, I care about our membership, and I care that everyone comes to Maplecrest and has a great time.

Hello Member!

We're excited to say the golf season is officially underway, even if the weather has been a bit unpredictable. It's been great seeing so many of you back out enjoying the course already.

With membership at an all-time high, pace of play will continue to be an important focus. Our posted pace is 3 hours and 45 minutes, and we ask everyone to help us achieve this by playing ready golf. Please remain aware of your position on the course and the group behind you. If your group falls behind, we kindly ask that you allow faster players to play through.

As a reminder, please follow all daily course guidelines shared via the app, email, and social media:

- Repair ball marks, fill divots with sand, and rake bunkers
- Keep golf carts at least 30 feet from greens and remain on paths around tees
- Follow range usage guidelines: mats when designated, grass when permitted
- Range balls are for members only; guest bags are available in the Golf Shop for \$5
- Check in at the Golf Shop prior to your round to avoid incorrect billing
- Do not tee off on Hole #10 without Golf Shop approval
- Limit turn time to 5 minutes or less (we will push the staff to serve you with this in mind)

For overall enjoyment and pace, we encourage less experienced players to take advantage of slower tee times on the tee sheet, such as weekday mornings or weekend afternoons.

Online tee time booking has been great to date, thank you for utilizing the system!

You can easily manage your reservations by clicking on the “Account” button within the booking engine to modify or cancel your tee time.

Currently, we do not have a “no-show” fee, and we hope to keep it that way. Please help us help you, and your fellow members, by being courteous and canceling your tee time if you are unable to make it.

ON THE COURSE - DEVIN SOLOVEY, GCSAA



Hello Member!

As you all know, the onsite drainage project has been a significant undertaking, but we're starting to see light at the end of the tunnel (no pun intended, as we quite literally installed a new tunnel!). This past week has been a true test of the new tile system, and it is performing exactly as intended. I'm very grateful to the Board and membership for their trust and support as we've pushed this project forward. The long-term benefits will be well worth it.

Many of you may have noticed that rough areas have been final graded and sodded. Fairways #3, #5, and #14 are now sodded, and as soon as conditions allow, we will complete the remaining fine turf areas.

We were also able to complete deep tine aeration and topdressing on Monday ahead of the heavy rains. While the weather has been challenging, the moisture will help the aeration holes heal quickly, and we anticipate a strong recovery on the greens as temperatures rise heading into May.

We plan to resume our tree planting program toward the end of the month, continuing to enhance the course's long-term playability and aesthetics.

Work continues on #13 tee, where we've been aggressively topdressing and applying treatments to promote outward growth. With improved weather, we expect to see significant progress in this area soon.

I'd also like to recognize our former Assistant, Cody VanderReyden, who has recently accepted his first Superintendent position at Black Squirrel Golf Course here in Goshen. Cody made a tremendous impact during his time at MCC, and while he will certainly be missed, we're excited to see him succeed in this next chapter. Thank you, Cody, for everything you've done for the Club and for me personally.

Lastly, I want to thank our entire grounds crew for their hard work and dedication. Since January, they've been managing the drainage project while preparing the course for the season ahead. If you see them on the course, please take a moment to thank them for all they do.

With summer staff arriving soon, we'll be fully staffed and ready to hit our stride. We truly appreciate your patience as we continue getting the course in top condition for the season.
